### What you need

- ✓ iPhone or iPad with iOS 13.1 or newer.
- ✓ Reunion 11, 12, 13, or 14 installed on your Mac.
- ✓ ReunionTouch installed on your iPhone or iPad.
- ✓ \$9.99 at the iOS App Store.
- ✓ Dropbox account (11-14) or iCloud Drive (13-14) (More about this from Bill George in June).



### Main Features

(Info comes from your entries on desktop Reunion)

- Person and family information includes names, events, notes, facts, flags, and contact info.
- Sources.
- Pictures linked to people, families and sources.
- Multiple family files are supported.



Note: Due to screen size, features are found in different places on the iPhone and iPad.

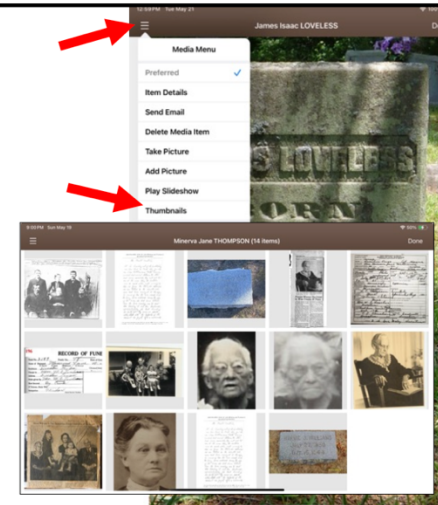

- . Add, change, and delete fields (names, addresses, facts, events, notes, and flags).
- . Edit and view stylized text in notes, sources, and logs.
- . Add new children, spouses, and parents.
- . Add unrelated people.
- . Change child status and child order.
- . Link to existing children and spouses.
- . Delete people.
- . Remove links to people.
- . Add new logs and sources.
- . Enter, convert Hebrew dates.
