MacFamily Tree Start Page

Here you end up importing a GEDCOM file, starting a new family tree, or selecting an existing family tree to edit. If there are any updates to the software, then they will appear at this time as well.



Main Page

This is the main page you'll be working in. It contains a list of people, different areas you can access and the main portion of the screen for what you'll be working on. This starts out as a view of the family tree you opened.



Left Menu

The left hand column affects what you see in the main screen. There are 4 sections that are controlled by the 4 tabs on the side – Edit, Views, Reports, and Export. It starts in the edit screen showing the family tree.



Right Window

The right-hand window shows a list of people in the tree. You can easily search in this list if you're looking for a specific person. Select that person and whatever you're working on in the main window will switch to that person as the main person.



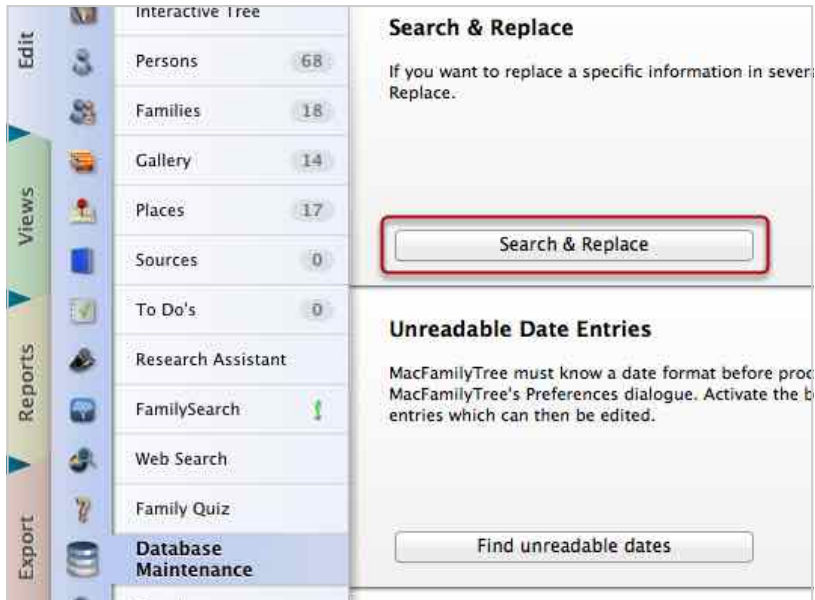
These are the main screens you'll be working in.

If you have a Family Search account then one of the more helpful areas is the connection the MFT has with Family Search. You can login, it will access your tree and you can see matches and updates for people in your MFT tree.





With the release of version 7, there are just a couple differences between Mobile Family Tree and Mac Family Tree. Those differences are Web Search, and Database maintenance.



The database maintenance allows you to search and replace specific entries, get consistent dates, reformat names, remove empty entries, and find duplicate persons.

You can also search the web for information through the interface and insert entries from your search into your database.
